Dojo awards are now as follows:

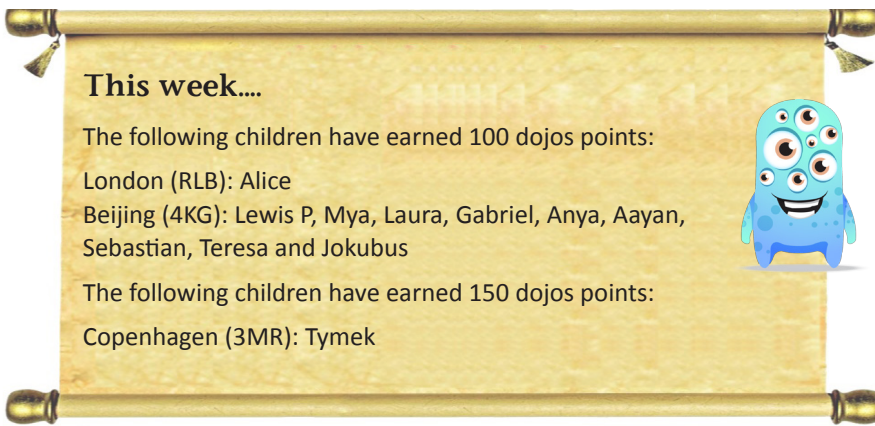
- Bronze certificate and change your monster = 50 points
