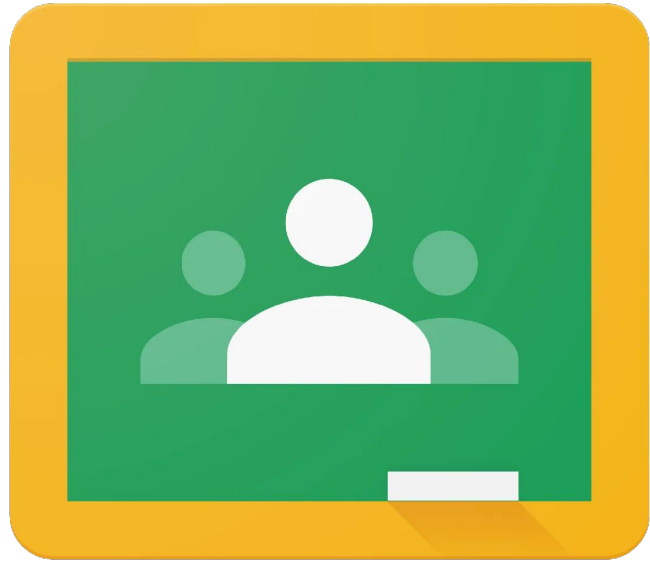

Remote Learning on Google Classroom: Reception to Year 6



Google Classroom

In the event of a lockdown or bubble closure, the children will be able to access remote learning through their school google account.

Daily lessons will be uploaded to the Google Classroom platform.

Lessons will include support materials and video explanations..

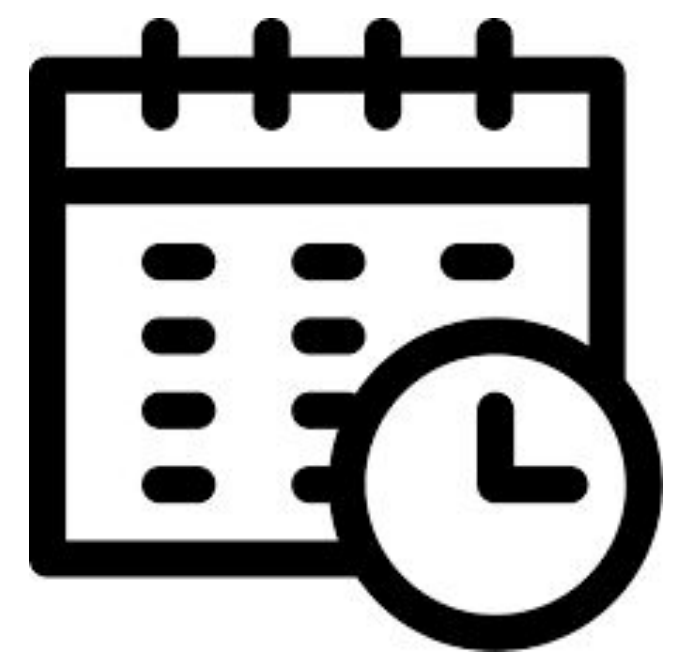
Children will be able to complete the lessons and upload work to be checked by the teachers and staff.

Attendance and Interaction is key

During a lockdown, it is important that children are interacting with remote learning and contact between the school exists.

Each day of a lockdown, teachers will hold a daily morning Zoom call for children to check in and discuss work.

Children will also be marked as present if they complete and turning in work using Google Classroom



Helpdesk emails have been created to communicate with staff

Look out for a weekly learning phone call



During a lockdown period, bubble closure or individual period of isolation from school, class teachers and support staff will make a weekly phone call to each child in their class.

This will be a chance to discuss work, talk about school and discuss any other information the children would like to share.

Calls will often be made using blocked caller ID's.

Don't forget the weekly Zoom call

During a lockdown period or bubble closure, a weekly class Zoom call will take place at an agreed time each week.

This will be a chance for the children to see each other and have a general catch up under the guidance of their class teacher.
